LEADER is an EU funding instrument helping rural regions to develop on their own terms. LEADER assists Local Action Groups (LAGs) in devising and implementing their local development strategy.

Responsibility for LEADER in Bavaria lies with the Bavarian State Ministry of Food, Agriculture and Forestry. Nine LEADER coordinators and awarding authorities in charge of agriculture act as central advisors and expert contacts.

The LEADER success story in Bavaria dates back 25 years. For the 2014 – 2020 programming period, there are 68 LAGs covering 86% of Bavaria's land area. Around €111 million of project funding is available during this period.

LEADER focuses on LAGs, partnerships between municipal, economic and socially committed players in the region. They devise a local development strategy for their region and use their project selection criteria to decide independently which projects will be funded by LEADER.
